REGARDING NSBU'S CONSIDERATION AND DECLARATION CONCERNING TWO NEW PUBLIC UTILITIES REGULATORY POLICIES ACT (PURPA) STANDARDS – (1) DEMAND RESPONSE AND DEMAND FLEXIBILITY AND (2) ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING PROGRAMS. NSBU GENERAL COUNSEL READS THE PROPOSED RESOLUTION BY TITLE ONLY. (GENERAL COUNSEL CLOUD READ THE TITLE OF PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01)

CHAIRMAN THEN ASKS FOR ANY COMMENTS, FOR OR OPPOSED TO NSBU'S CONSIDERATION AND DECLARATION CONCERNING THE TWO NEW PURPA STANDARDS. (THERE WERE NO EXTERNAL PUBLIC COMMENTS FOR OR OPPOSED TO NSBU'S CONSIDERATION AND DECLARATION RE: THE TWO NEW PURPA STANDARDS)

(G.C. CLOUD EXPLAINED BY PASSING THE PROPOSED RESOLUTION – NO. 2023-01, NSBU WILL BE STATING THEY HAVE CONSIDERED THE TWO NEW PURPA STANDARDS AND HAVE DECIDED NOT TO ADOPT THEM)

(COMMS. HAWES READ A PERSONAL STATEMENT/OPINION INTO THE RECORD. CAUTIONED AGAINST THE ADOPTION OF PRACTICES OR PROCEDURES, EVEN IF CONSIDERED GOVERNMENTAL, REGULATORY, OR BUSINESS MANDATES, THAT COULD DIMINISH NSBU'S ABILITY TO PROVIDE COST-EFFECTIVE, SAFE AND RELIABLE POWER AND WATER SERVICES. ALSO ENCOURAGED COMMISSIONERS AND MANAGEMENT TO BE PREPARED TO MAKE DIFFICULT DECISIONS IF AND WHEN REQUIRED TO SUPPORT THIS OBLIGATION)
